Leverage Ratio 2Q 2017

Qualitative

Leverage Ratio di kuartal-2 2017 menurun ke level 5.78% dibandingkan kuartal sebelumnya di level 5.98%, namun masih dalam limit minimal 3%. Penurunan leverage ratio di kuartal-2 ini disebabkan karena adanya penurunan di Tier 1 Capital sebesar IDR 39 miliar dan kenaikan dari total exposur sebesar IDR 2.1 triliun. Kenaikan exposur terbesar terlihat dari pos on balance sheet item seperti pinjaman kredit dan surat berharga dan penurunan terbesar terlihat dari pos securities financing transaction (SFT) exposur, dari transaksi reverse repo sebesar IDR 2.3 triliun.
