Commemorating 50th Anniversary in Indonesia, Citi Indonesia Hosted IDX Market Opening Ceremony

Jakarta, July 2, 2018 – Commemorating 50th Anniversary in Indonesia, Citi Indonesia (Citibank) is honored to host today's IDX market opening ceremony. The event was conducted by **CEO of Citibank Indonesia Batara Sianturi** and **President Director of Indonesia Stock Exchange Inarno Djajadi**, witnessed by the management as well as employees of Citi Indonesia and the management of Indonesia Stock Exchange.

CEO of Citibank Indonesia Batara Sianturi said, "It is an honor for Citibank to host the opening market ceremony today at the Indonesia Stock Exchange with the second largest capitalization in ASEAN. The IDX has recorded many achievements both in terms of the number of issuers as well as the increase in market capitalization. I believe that a strong capital market and banking industry will be the key to success for Indonesia's current and future economic growth."

Through underwriter PT Citigroup Sekuritas Indonesia (PT CSI), a company affiliated with Citibank N.A., Indonesia (Citi Indonesia) has been active as a member of the Indonesia Stock Exchange since July 2010. PT CSI's flagship products include Equity Research, Equity Brokerage and Equity Underwriting / IPO.

PT CSI is currently the top five global equity house in terms of transaction value in IDX (Bursa Efek Indonesia/BEI). Supported by 6 research analysts covering 62 stocks, this year PT CSI is awarded first rank in 2018 Investor Institutional Survey for Indonesia. In addition to stock trading, PT CSI is also active in Initial Public Offering (IPO) for several companies in Indonesia, so far PT CSI has handled one IPO in 2018 and two IPOs in 2016.

Since August 2017, Citibank has established a partnership with PT Kliring Penjaminan Efek Indonesia (KPEI) to provide Account Operator services in Indonesia, as well as signing a Memorandum of Understanding between Citibank and PT CSI to provide Account Operator services. Citibank become the first Custodian Bank to offer account operator services such as settlement for securities trading and asset servicing to securities companies which need such services.

This initiative helps to improve the efficiency of Indonesia's capital markets, as well as the competitiveness of securities firms by enabling them to transfer their fixed operational costs to a variable cost model and to move the operational risk to their selected custodian banks. By doing so, securities firms can focus their internal resources on key activities to boost trading volumes.

At the ceremony, **Batara Sianturi** said, "Citibank's 50 years of dedication to Indonesia is a realization of our commitment, and we look forward to continue contributing to Indonesia's economic growth and advancing the national financial industry."
