Citi Foundation Donates More Than Rp 2 Billion (US\$ 150,000) to Indonesia for COVID-19 Relief Efforts

Jakarta, July 13 2020 –Citi Foundation is donating more than Rp 2 Billion (US\$ 150,000)¹ for COVID-19 relief efforts in Indonesia. The donation will be distributed by Citi's community partner HOPE worldwide Indonesia to benefit several cities in the country, namely Jakarta, Tangerang, Semarang, Bandung, Medan, Denpasar and Surabaya.

Citi Indonesia CEO Batara Sianturi stated, "Citi has an unwavering commitment to serve our community. During this difficult time, we want to take an active role in helping to alleviate the impact of the pandemic, especially for those who are vulnerable and underprivileged, as well as medical front-liners. We always strive to embody Citi's values through our philanthropic efforts and core businesses so that we are able to provide sustainable impacts to those in need."

Selected to assist the distribution of this donation is HOPE worldwide Indonesia. A member of HOPE Worldwide which focuses on community empowerment and disaster response, the organization will distribute the donation in the form of 3,000 food and nutrition packages, 1,000 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and 8 mobile hand washing units. The donation will also be used to further promote clean and healthy living to minimize the spread of COVID-19 through series of communication activities and capacity buildings.

HOPE worldwide Indonesia Country Director Lily Salim said, "The COVID-19 is prevalent everywhere in world, including Indonesia, and has caused a great deal of impact to the communities. And in this regard, we appreciate the opportunity to work alongside Citi Indonesia in the collective effort to fight this pandemic."

This also marks Citi Indonesia's second donation for COVID-19 relief efforts. Citi Indonesia, in partnership with PT. BNP Paribas Asset Management (PT BNP Paribas AM) had previously donated Rp 500 million to Red Cross Indonesia and UNICEF Indonesia. The donation was an extension from BNP Paribas IDX30 Filantropi, a socially responsible themed index fund managed by PT. BNP Paribas AM, and will be channelled in the form of Personal Protective Equipment as well as education programs on health, sanitation, and protection for children. As an additional effort, Citi Indonesia staffs will also be given the opportunity to showcase their act of kindness by providing personal donations through Hope worldwide Indonesia as part of Citi's Annual Global Community Day campaign.

Globally, Citi and Citi Foundation have committed over than Rp 1 trillion (US\$100 million) in support of COVID-19 related community relief and economic recovery efforts. This includes more than Rp 29 billion (US\$ 2 million) contribution from Citi employees through a donation matching program which will be directed to several NGOs namely United Nations Development Programme, International Rescue Committee, International Organization for Migration and Direct Relief.
