### **Citi Named Best Bank in Indonesia by The Asset Magazine**

**Jakarta, 15 January 2016** – Citi Indonesia once again named as Best Bank by the Asset Magazine. This is Citi Indonesia's 14<sup>th</sup> win in a row as Best Bank. The Asset Triple A Awards are Asia's preeminent recognitions for those that have excelled in their respective industry.

During the award ceremony held in Hong Kong last night, Chief Executive Officer of Citi Indonesia, Batara Sianturi stated, "These recognitions symbolize the trust and commitment that our clients have of us. We are very pleased to receive the awards which will surely encourage us to strengthen Citi position in Indonesia as the bank with trusted global networks, exceptional digital services, comprehensive financial services, and high quality human resources."

In addition to the Best Bank category, Citi Indonesia also received 4 additional recognitions namely as Best Corporate and Institutional Bank in Indonesia; Best Loan House; Best Deal of the year for the issuance of the Republic of Indonesia US\$ 4 billion 144A/Reg S 10-year/30-year Fixed Rate Notes due 2025/2045, in which Citi acted as one of the joint bookrunners; Best Corporate Bond for the issuance of US\$1.6 billion global bonds for Pelindo II in which Citi acted as one of the bookrunners.

In the annual Triple-A country awards for 2015, the Asset Magazine named Citi as the Best Bank in 9 markets, namely in Indonesia, China, India, Korea, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam. For many countries this marked over a decade of winning these awards – including Indonesia for 14 years in a row, Philippines 12 years in a row with Korea and Taiwan both at 13 years. This year also marked the 9th year in a row for China to win best bank.

In the Asia Pacific region, Citi has helped raised up to US\$200bn and close to US\$100bn of M&A advised during the year for clients. These were also recognized via the investment banking and capital market country awards.

Citi, the globe's leading financial company, has approximately 200 million customers and conducts business transactions in more than 140 countries. Citi offers a range of financial products and services to individuals, corporations, governments and institutions.
